

Golf Course Maintenance Worker

Job Specification Classification: Golf Course

Series: Maintenance

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is a seasonal position involving responsibility for efficient maintenance of a municipal golf course grounds and its facilities. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, maintenance and repair of greens, tees, fairways, facilities and equipment. The work is performed under the direction of the Golf Course Maintenance Supervisor. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

- Performs construction on tees, greens and fairways;
- Performs mowing, watering and maintenance of tees, greens and fairways;
- Performs various planting and maintenance tasks;
- Operates various types of equipment;

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Ability to assist in the construction and maintenance of golf course tees, greens, and fairways;
- Ability to assist with drainage control methods and water irrigation systems including, pumps and controls:
- Basic knowledge of grounds maintenance methods and techniques;
- Ability to prepare basic reports;
- Possess good professional judgment and initiative.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and one (1) years of satisfactory experience in the construction or operation and maintenance of a golf course or similar park facilities, OR;
- (B) Any equivalent combination of training and experience sufficient to indicate ability to do the work.

Licensing requirements: Must possess and maintain a valid NYS driver's license.
